### *Research and teaching interests*

Laura Navne is a medical anthropologist, specialized in medical anthropology. Intensive care medicine, pediatrics, reproduction, medical education, decision-making, and ethics are at the heart of Laura's more than ten years career of research. Currently, Laura is engaged in post graduate research on the ethics in genetics, exploring the ethical and social implications of the emergence of precision medicine and the use of new gene-technologies (exome sequencing) in Danish health care. Between 2013 and 2020, Laura has done research on medical education in obstetrics and newborn

medicine in collaboration with the University Hospital of Copenhagen and professor in Interprofessional Learning, Dr. Jette Led Sørensen. In her PhD from 2017, Laura studied practices and experiences of life-and-death decisions in the largest neonatal intensive care unit in Denmark. From 2005 to 2007 Laura lived in Greenland conducting fieldwork on reproductive decision-making, kinship and life course perspectives. Laura is an experienced teacher in qualitative methods and ethnographic fieldwork. Laura has for many years been engaged in cross-disciplinary collaborations, working together with political scientists, medical doctors, midwives etc.
